CAMP DISCIPLINE POLICY

- Summer Camp has **a zero tolerance policy for violence**. Campers who are caught in a violent act will be required to remain home the following day (or be expelled from camp depending on the severity of the act). No camp refunds will be given.
- If a second violent act is performed, the camper will be expelled from camp and not allowed to return.
- The counselor or the Camp Director will handle discipline. Parents will be notified immediately and a discipline report will be issued.
- Campers may be required to abstain from certain camp activities for not obeying camp rules; be sent to the Camp Director for defiant behavior; or be required to call parents to pick the camper up for extreme behavior. If inappropriate behavior persists the camper may be expelled from camp.

The following are all examples of inappropriate behavior:

- Disrespect, rudeness to other adults or campers
- Horseplay
- Inappropriate behavior/language
- Public display of affection
- Bullying – intentional, hurtful behavior perpetuated over a period of times in a relationship characterized by an unbalance of power.
- Direct disobedience
- Profanity, cursing
- Lying/dishonesty
- Hitting, putting your hands on someone else
- Vandalism
- Verbal/Written harassment
- Fighting
- Stealing

At the discretion of the Director, the parents may be asked to pick up a child for the remainder of the day.

Consequences – first offence is usually a verbal warning; thereafter consequences may be time out, missing an activity, parent called, or camper sent home.

CAMP POLICIES

- **Anyone picking up a camper will be required to show ID.** Once workers become familiar with parents, ID may not be required. However, ID will always be required of someone other than a parent or normal pick-up person.
- Only persons listed as emergency contacts will be allowed to pick up camper.
- **All clothing, lunch boxes, and backpacks must be labeled with the camper's name.** ASCS is not responsible for any items lost while participating in summer programs.
- All campers will receive a summer camp t-shirt included in fee. Please have your camper(s) wear their camp t-shirt on days when camp t-shirts are required (for certain field trips).
- **Please bring a labeled water bottle for your child.**

Summer Camp

Summer Camp is a program of Atlantic Shores Christian School (ASCS). All of our camp employees and counselors are professing believers in Jesus Christ. Each employee fully accepts ASCS's Statement of Faith and will represent their faith and these beliefs in their daily responsibilities at summer camp.

When enrolling your child in the ASCS Summer Camp, you agree to respect the school's beliefs and agree not to act in any way that would be detrimental or contrary to our school's Statement of Faith.

ASCS Statement of Faith

We believe in:

1. One God in three persons; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Isaiah 45:5, Matthew 28:19, Acts 5:3-4, Colossians 2:9)
2. Jesus Christ as the only way to salvation. We are saved by grace through faith. (Acts 4:12, John 14:6, Ephesians 2:8-9)
3. The verbal, inerrant inspiration and authority of the Scripture in both Old and New Testaments. (II Timothy 3:16-17, II Peter 1:20-21)
4. The Genesis account of the creation of man in six days by the direct act of God. (Genesis 1:1-28)
5. The incarnation, deity, virgin birth, and bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ. (Matthew 1:18, John 1:1&14, John 20:26-29, I Corinthians 15:1-20)
6. The vicarious suffering of Jesus Christ for the sins of the world and the shedding of His blood on the cross to cleanse us from sin. (Philippians 2:6-11, I Peter 1:18 & 2:24, Ephesians 1:7, Colossians 1:19-23, Matthew 27:32-55)
7. The new birth through regeneration by the Holy Spirit as essential to salvation. (John 14:16-17, Titus 3:5, John 3:6-7)
8. The gift of eternal life and eternal security of the believer by the grace of God. (John 10:27-29, Philippians 1:6, II Timothy 1:12, I Peter 1:3-5)
9. The local church as the primary place of fellowship and growth of believers and for the evangelization of the world with the gospel. (Acts 2:38 & 2:42-47, Matthew 18:20, Hebrews 10:24-25, I Corinthians 12:12-27, Matthew 28:19)
10. The person and work of the Holy Spirit and the need for Christian growth and service. (John 14:16-26 & 16:8-11, Ephesians 4:11-12)
11. The visible, personal, and imminent return of our Lord Jesus Christ. (I Thessalonians 4:13-17)
12. The everlasting conscious blessedness of the saved and the everlasting conscious punishment of the lost. (John 3:36, Luke 16:19-31, Hebrews 7:23-25)
13. Marriage as a covenant between one man and one woman with sexual intimacy confined to this marriage covenant (Genesis 2:22-24, Ephesians 5:22-33, Proverbs 18:22). We believe that any form of sexual immorality, such as adultery, fornication, homosexuality, bisexual conduct, incest, or any attempt to change one's sex or disagreement with one's biological sex, is sinful and contrary to God's word, the Bible (Exodus 20:14, Mark 7:21, Leviticus 18:22, Romans 1:26-27, I Corinthians 6:9).
