COLLEGE Prep and ADVANCED HONORS COURSES:

- ASCS currently offers twenty-two honors and nine dual enrollment courses. Honors classes are available to students in grades 7-12. College dual enrollment courses, available to juniors and seniors, are taught on our campus by our faculty who serve as adjunct college professors.
- Over 50% of our total student body is enrolled in one or more honors or college dual enrollment courses.
- In the 2015-16 school year, juniors and seniors collectively earned 256 semester hours of college credit through our college dual enrollment.
- Ten students in the class of 2016 received the Early College Scholars Award having earned fifteen or more semester hours of college credit. 35% of the students in this class received the Advanced Honors Diploma.

STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES:

- In 2016, 7th graders as a group scored at the 80th percentile on the Terra Nova Achievement Test.
- In 2016, 8th graders scored as a group scored at 81st percentile on the Terra Nova Achievement Test.

NATIONAL MERIT SCHOLARS:

- Seventeen of our students have been named National Merit Scholars and three have been named semi-finalists or finalists. These students rank in the top 3% of the juniors who take the PSAT exam nationally.

MERIT BASED SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:

- Thirty-eight members of the class of 2016 were offered over \$2,800,000 in merit based scholarships, an average of over \$75,900 per student.

HONOR SOCIETIES:

- Over 50% of our students are members of the National Honor Society, National Art Honor Society, Tri-M National Musical Honor Society, Thespian Honor Society, National Spanish Honor Society, or Junior National Honor Society.

FACULTY QUALIFICATIONS:

- At the secondary campus, 45% of faculty and administration hold masters or doctoral degrees.
