DESCRIPTION

Atlantic Shores Christian School is an independent, non-denominational Christian day school. It is a private, non-profit institution. ASCS is accredited by Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) and the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI).

DEMOGRAPHICS

In the fall of 1985, ASCS opened its doors with 68 students in grades K4 through third. The fourth through the sixth grades were added in 1986 and seventh through twelfth grades in 1987. Currently the school serves as an education institution for approximately 785 students in preschool through the twelfth grade.

The school has two campuses. The elementary school (K3-Grade 6) is located in Virginia Beach and the secondary school (Grades 7-12) in the city of Chesapeake. Both cities are a part of the Tidewater Hampton Roads community which consists of five interconnected cities with a population of more than one million people. Virginia Beach itself has a total population of more than 440,000. The city of Chesapeake has more than 225,000.
