TUITION AND FEE SCHEDULE 2019-2020

Application Fee: (New Students Only – K3 through 12th grade) – There is a \$75 *non-refundable* application fee for each new K3 – 12th grade student making application to enter ASCS.

Books and Enrollment Fee: To be paid in full at the time of each student's enrollment (*Non-refundable*). A student is not enrolled or guaranteed placement until the Books and Enrollment Fee is paid and a financial contract signed.

Multiple-Student Tuition Discount: Families with two or more children will receive a tuition discount for each child as follows: (Student in the highest grade level is considered as the first child.)

2nd child – 10%

3rd child – 25%

4th child and up – 40%

Payment Plan Options:

- 1) **Payment In Full:** Families who pay 'Tuition and Annual Fees' in full by June 1, 2019 will receive a discount of 2.5% off the net amount owed after all other discounts have been applied.
- 2) **Monthly Payment Plan:** Families who do not use the Payment-in-Full Plan are required to enroll in the monthly payment plan using **FACTS Tuition Management – Automatic Withdrawal Program**. There is no added fee for the FACTS Tuition Management automatic withdrawal program when using your checking account. For those families wishing to pay by credit or debit card, there is an additional convenience fee assessed to the payment. Enrollment in FACTS can be done through the school business office or online at www.shoreschristian.org (Admissions tab). Monthly tuition payments are due on the first of each month beginning July 2019 through May 2020 (11 month plan). Students enrolling after July 1 will be required to pay the equivalent of one month of 'Tuition and Annual Fees' immediately upon enrolling with the balance spread over the remaining months through May 2020. **Students who enroll after July 20, 2019 will have their annual tuition and fees spread over a shorter contract period resulting in higher monthly payments.**

Late Fee: A late fee of \$50 will be assessed if there is an outstanding balance on the sixth of the month.

Financial Aid: Families in need of financial aid must apply through our outside provider, FACTS Grant & Aid.

Applications must be submitted to FACTS along with a \$35 application fee by going online at www.factstuitionaid.com. Financial aid is only available to students in Full-day Kindergarten through 12th grade. Financial Aid award applies only to Tuition and not to the Annual Fees. Returning families must apply for financial aid and re-enroll (pay Books & Enrollment Fee and electronically sign their family contract) by April 30, 2019. Returning families who re-enroll and apply for Financial Aid after April 30, 2019 will receive a reduced financial aid award from the school.

Alumni Discount: Please see our website for details regarding the tuition discount for alumni children.

Senior Fee: An additional \$200 Fee will be added to the tuition and fees for all seniors to cover cap & gown, tassel, cords, diploma, cap & gown photography fees, and the senior government trip to Washington, D. C.

Athletic Program Fees:

Little Seahawks (3 rd – 6 th grades)	\$45 per athlete/sport.

S.T.E.M. Academy: A selective, rigorous academic program with a focus in Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics (fees are in addition to tuition).

Resource Program Fees: A supplemental academic program that supports and equips students with educational challenges to become lifelong learners (fees are in addition to tuition).

K3 – 6 th grades	\$250/month	Math & reading taught 5 days per week with classroom modification and accommodations per IEP (payment begins September 1).
K3 – 12 th grades	\$30/month	Students with 504 plans requiring classroom modifications and accommodations (must have documented learning disability).
7 th – 12 th grades	\$250/month \$150/month	5 days a week, 1 credit 3 days a week

Testing Fee:

K3 – 6 th grades	\$75	All new students entering K5-6 th grades are required to be tested after being accepted and enrolled at ASCS.

Dual Enrollment College Courses at the secondary campus carry additional tuition and fees.

Extended Care: ASCS offers before and after school care at both the elementary and secondary campuses. Application forms with the hours and cost are available on the school's website and at both school offices.

New Families: Upon completion of an enrollment application, new families to ASCS must schedule an appointment with the principal/dean for an interview. After acceptance, the new family must also meet with the Admissions Office to finalize the financial contract.

A student is not enrolled or guaranteed placement until a financial contract is completed and the Books and Enrollment Fee is paid.
